Treatment of Laterally Positioned Periapical Lesions by Routine Endodontic Treatment

The apical third region of the root canal may have many routes as lateral canals or laterally positioned foramen. Periapical lesions are formed due to the invasion of bacteria from the pulp canal to the periapical area. These lesions may be seen by a radiograph and the route that caused the lesions has to be analysed.

Endodontic treatment modalities have to be modified in order that these laterally positioned routes have to be cleaned, disinfected and obturated.

This lecture will present follow up of cases treated teeth and healed periapical pathologies by routine endodontic lesions.
